

KCA PLAYERS REGISTRATION RULES

Amendment - 1

The following amendment is issued to the KCA Players registration rules ref : GDO/DOC1/2018/Rev2 dt 25.Dec 2018 and will effective from the season 2019-20.

Objective : to permit dual registration so that a player can play league matches in his home district and also in another district of his choice with the permission of parent club and DCA. However, a player registered with TNCA for playing league there shall not be eligible for dual registration.

For the above, the following amendments are proposed to incorporate a provision for dual registration.

I. Annual Registration *(amended to read as)*

A player can only be registered with his parent club in his home district and also seek a dual registration as "LEAGUE GUEST PLAYER " in another district of his choice as per the conditions mentioned in clause II (2) hereunder.

II. Under Eligibility Criteria, (Ref: Clause – 2): "League Guest Player": *(amended to read as)*

A registered club shall be permitted to register maximum of 5 (five) players in the team as "League Guest Players" and maximum of 3 (Three) such players in the playing XI for the district league matches. Such players are those who satisfy eligibility criteria under Clause II – (1) above in another district (home district) . But these players prefer to play for a club outside their home district for genuine reasons like proximity to the district being in the border areas, better facilities and opportunities, etc,. Such (guest) players are required to submit a no objection certificate (NoC) from the parent club and home DCA for registering with a club in the host DCA at the time of annual registration. These players shall be allowed to play league matches in the home district as well as in the DCA where he is permitted to register as "League Guest Player" under following conditions only :

- (i) It is mandatory for such players to play league in his home district before seeking dual registration status.
- (ii) The dual registration as guest player shall be permitted to play his second league as guest player only in A or B division league matches , where the minimum over per side in not less than 45 overs.
- (iii) A player registered with TNCA for playing league matches in Chennai is not eligible for dual registration.

Clause V : Provision for Guest Player in tournaments *(amended to read as)*

Ref (Clause – 6) : For the purpose of restricting the no off guest players, the maximum guest players a team can have is limited to 5 (Five) in the playing XI, which is inclusive of any league guest players registered under clause II (2) . These players shall remain unchanged during the course of the whole tournament and for the particular team.

All other prevailing provisions of the KCA Registration rules shall remain the same.
