## ELECTION TO THE KERALA CRICKET ASSOCIATION

### ELECTION GUIDELINES/INSTRUCTIONS

The Electoral Officer appointed as provided by Sub Rule 1 of Rule 33 of the Rules and Regulations of the Kerala Cricket Association hereby issues the following instructions/guidelines for the conduct of elections to the Kerala Cricket Association:-

1. The election shall be conducted for electing the five Office Bearers of the Kerala Cricket Association and one Councillor to the Apex Council of the Kerala Cricket Association as stipulated in the Rules and Regulations of the Kerala Cricket Association as modified/amended by the Judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard.
2. The draft electoral roll shall be published at 11 A.M on 08.12.2025 on the notice board of the office of the Electoral Officer and at the Head Quarters of the Kerala Cricket Association, Thiruvananthapuram.

3. Objections, if any, to the draft electoral roll shall be presented to the Electoral Officer, or his authorised representative at his office between 11 a.m. and 4 p.m. from 08.12.2025 to 10.12.2025, in person or by post. Any objection which is not lodged within the period specified above shall be summarily rejected..
4. The Electoral Officer shall hold hearing on the objections at 11 A.M on 11.12.2025 at the Office of the Electoral Officer. At the hearing, the objector and the person objected to and an authorised representative of the Kerala Cricket Association shall be entitled to appear and be heard.
5. The Electoral Officer shall publish the final electoral roll at 3 P.M on 11.12.2025 on the notice board of the office of the Electoral Officer and the Head Quarters of the Kerala Cricket Association. No changes shall be allowed on any account after publication of the final electoral roll.
6. Nomination papers can be obtained free of cost from the office of the Electoral Officer or from the office of the Kerala Cricket Association from 11A.M to 4 P.M on 12.12.2025 and 15.12.2025. A candidate or his proposer or seconder shall, in person, deliver to the Electoral Officer or his authorised representative at his office the nomination paper completed in the prescribed form, signed by the candidate, the proposer and the seconder between 11A.M and 5 P.M on 12.12.2025 and 15.12.2025 as provided in the election schedule. No nomination paper shall be accepted after the specified time and date.
7. A person whose name appears in the final electoral roll and who does not suffer any disqualification enumerated in the Rules and Regulations of the Kerala Cricket Association, as modified/amended by the Judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in this regard, can contest in the election for one post. The candidate shall ensure himself that he is qualified to contest in the election and that he does not suffer from any disqualification.

8. A person nominated as a candidate for a particular post of the Office Bearer shall not be nominated for another post of the Office Bearer or the post of Councillor of the Apex Council. If a candidate is nominated to contest election for more than one post, all his nominations are liable to be rejected.
9. Scrutiny of nomination papers shall be held at the office of Electoral Officer from 11 A.M on 16.12.2025. The candidate, the proposer or the seconder and any other person duly authorised by the candidate in writing may attend at the time of scrutiny. After scrutiny, the Electoral Officer shall publish the list of validly nominated candidates at 11 a.m. on 17.12.2025.
10. Any validly nominated candidate may withdraw his candidature by a notice in writing and delivered to the Electoral officer between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m on 18.12.2025 and 19.12.2025 either by himself or by his Proposer or Seconder who has been authorised in this behalf in writing by such candidate. No candidate who has given a notice of withdrawal of his candidature shall be allowed to cancel the notice. The Electoral Officer shall publish the list of contesting candidates at 11 A.M on 22.12.2025.
11. If there is only one contesting candidate for a particular post, the Electoral Officer shall declare him to be duly elected at 11 A.M on 29.12.2025 and a certificate of election shall be issued to him. If the number of contesting candidate for a post is more than one, a poll shall be held at the Conference Hall of the Kerala Cricket Association from 10 A.M. to 1 P.M on 27.12.2025. The counting of votes shall be held there at 10 A.M on 29.12.2025. The results of election shall be declared at the General Body Meeting of the Kerala Cricket Association on 29.12.2025.
12. A contesting candidate may appoint a person as his election agent. He may also appoint another person as his polling and counting agent in connection with the poll and counting.

13. Polling shall be by means of secret ballot. Each voter can cast six votes, five votes to the various posts of the office bearers and one vote to the post of Councillor of the Apex Council.

14. The number of candidates to be elected is six. No voter shall cast his votes in favour of more than one candidate for a particular post and if he does so, his vote to that particular post shall be declared as invalid. Therefore, utmost care must be taken to ensure that only one vote is cast in favour of one candidate for a particular post. Every elector to whom a ballot paper has been issued shall maintain secrecy of voting within the polling station. Votes can be recorded by putting clearly the 'X' mark in the space provided against the name of the candidate in the ballot paper.

15. A voter shall bring any one of the following identity cards at the poll.

1. Voter's ID card
2. Aadhar Card
3. Pan Card
4. Driving Licence
5. Passport

16. On completion of counting of votes, the Electoral Officer shall forthwith declare that the candidate, who obtained the largest number of valid votes for each post as elected and shall issue him a certificate of election. If after counting of votes an equality of votes is found to exist between any candidates, the Electoral Officer shall forthwith decide between those candidates by lot and proceed as if the candidate on whom the lot falls had received an additional vote and declare him to be elected.

17.No mobile phone shall be permitted inside the polling station.
