Kerala Cricket Association (KCA) is inviting Expression of Interest from a reputed Hospital for Medical Partner for the IDFC FIRST BANK INDIA VS NEW ZEALAND T20I scheduled to be held on 31st January 2026, at The Sports Hub, Greenfield International Stadium, Thiruvananthapuram.

Scope of Work

The selected Medical Partner shall be responsible for providing **comprehensive medical support** to players, match officials, and spectators across all match and practice days of the tournament, as per the standards followed in national and international cricket tournaments.

A. Services for Teams and Match Officials

1. Designated Hospital

- Tie-up with a reputed hospital near the match venue and team hotels.
- 24x7 trauma care, advanced diagnostics, ICU, and multi-specialty support.

2. Medical Panel

- A dedicated **Medical Coordinator**
- Qualified doctors in: Emergency, Orthopaedics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Cardiology, Radiology, Pathology, Dentistry, General Surgery, and Pharmacy
- Contact list to be shared with team managers

3. Stadium Deployment (Per Match Day)

- 1 Senior Doctor (ALS certified)
- 1 Orthopaedic Doctor
- 1 Critical Care Nurse

- 2 Trained Stretcher Bearers
 - 2 ALS-equipped Ambulances (one active, one standby)
4. **Players' Medical Room Setup**
- Located near dressing rooms but outside restricted area
 - Equipped with emergency medical equipment, supplies, and sports therapy units
5. **Medical Equipment Requirement (Indicative List):**
Includes AED, Oxygen Cylinder, Spine Boards, Hot/Cold Packs, Physiotherapy Equipment, Sterile Kits, Bandages, Slings, Emergency Medicines, etc.

B. Services for Spectators

1. **Spectators' Medical Room (Sector J):**
- Fully functional room with AC, TV, fridge, minor treatment capacity (suturing, rehydration, etc.)
2. **First Aid Stations:**
- Adequately staffed and spaced across spectator areas
 - Clearly signposted in English and Malayalam
3. **Ambulance Support:**
- 2 ambulances including at least 1 ALS
 - Must be on-site 1 hour before gates open
 - Easy ingress/egress for emergency movement

Eligibility Criteria

- NABH/NABL accredited hospital or ISO-certified medical service provider
- Proven experience in managing medical services for large-scale sports/public events
- 24x7 trauma care and emergency response capabilities
- Readiness to provide required ambulances, medical professionals, and equipment

Submission Guidelines

Interested parties are requested to submit their EOI containing the following:

- Profile of the organization
- Proposed hospital(s) and medical staff deployment plan
- Details of past experience in similar events
- Any additional value-added services
